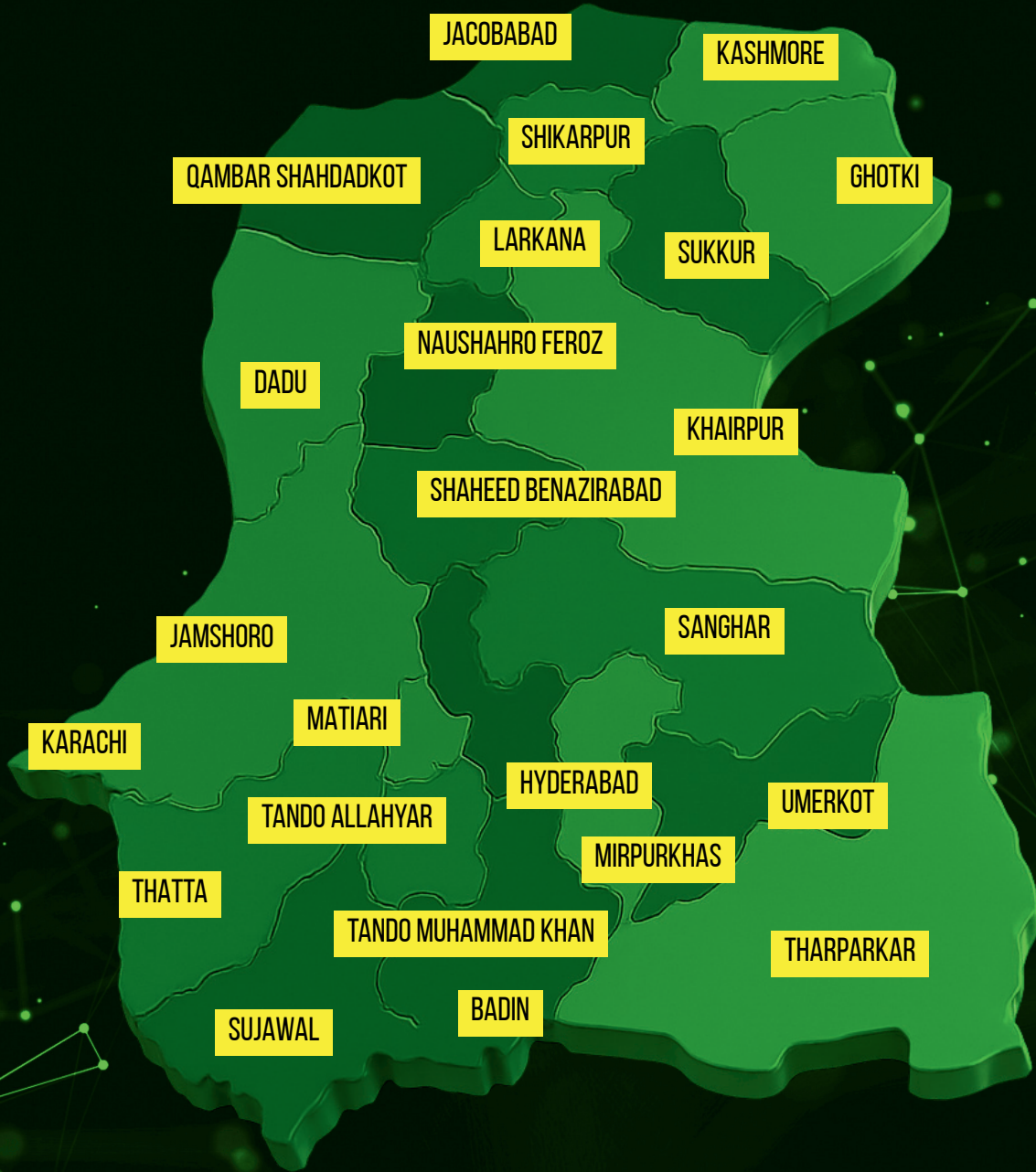

## MoU Signing Between BBSHRRDB and TANG International Education Group



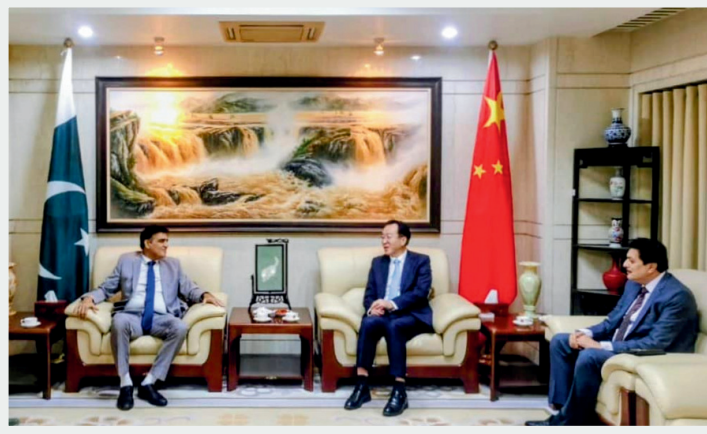

## BBSHRRDB and BISP Strengthen Partnership to Expand Skill Development Opportunities Across Sindh

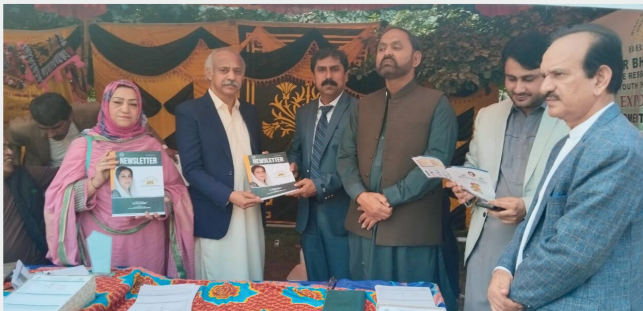

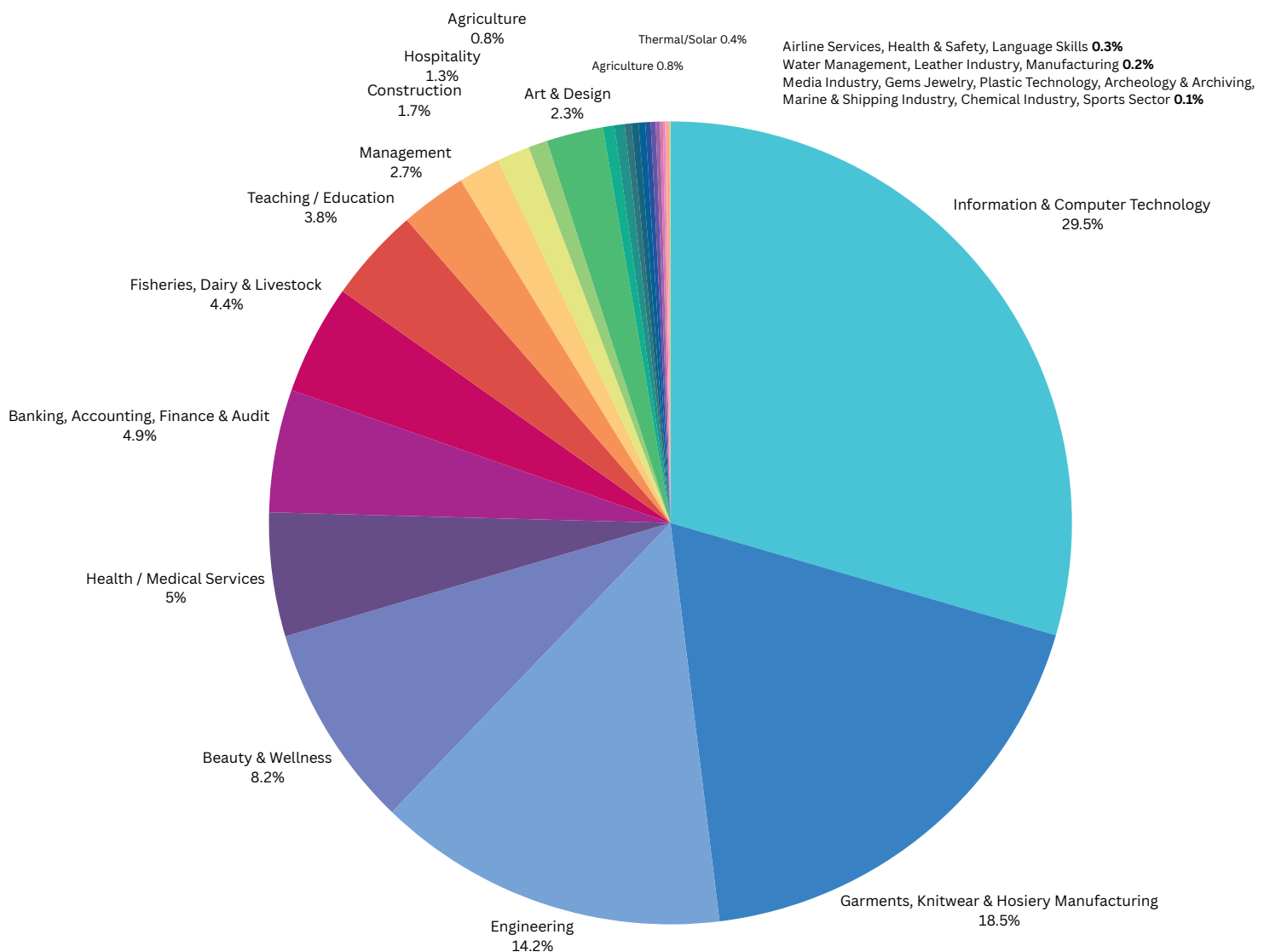
### KSEZ MEETING
